**Goal 2: How will the district provide coordination, technical assistance, and other support necessary to assist participating schools in planning and implementing effective parental engagement?**

3. Teachers are required to attend professional development about parental involvement on the state's rotation. Mentors work with new staff to discuss and provide resources in regards to parent communication. Teachers are asked to encourage parents to email and meet with them in regards to their children. Administration encourages teachers to reach out to parents for many reasons, not just when grades are low or behavior is lacking.
